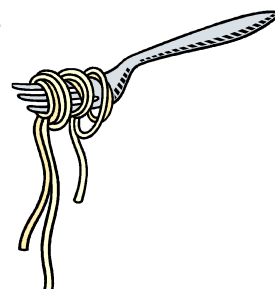
Please come along and think about taking on a position. Without a P & C the school will not be able to have all the little extras that the P & C helps out with.
