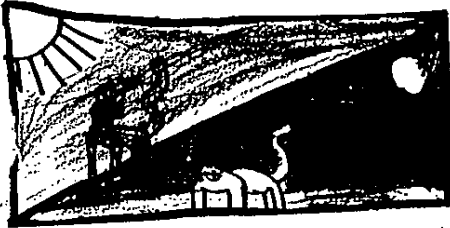
Research by Year 2

I learnt that polar bears eat fish.

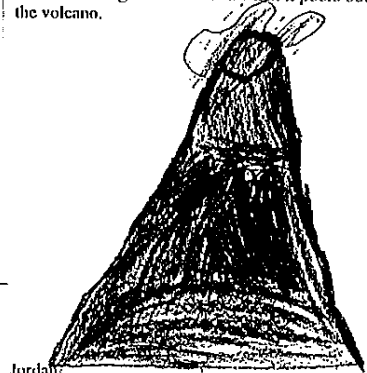

I found out that the liquid rock is called magma when it is under the ground and lava when it pours out of the volcano.

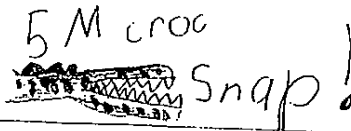

I found out that a rocket is pushed into space by burning gases.

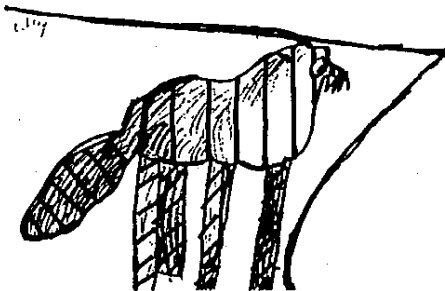
