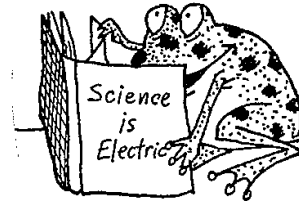


The **new menu** is going out today with the newsletter and is effective as of next Monday 23rd May.

# Simple Circuit



Year 5/6 are studying a science unit on energy. They have been making simple circuits. They used some electrical wire, batteries and small light bulbs.

They have learnt that electricity needs a complete path, called a circuit, in order to flow through to light a bulb.

When they attach the wires to a battery and a light bulb, they create a closed circuit and the light bulb will glow.

When they take the wire off, they broke the circuit and electricity could no longer flow. The bulb would not glow.
