We enjoyed practicing for our assembly item "Susie Had a Baby" . The children sang well and played their parts enthusiastically.

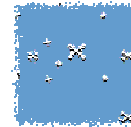
Thank you to the parents who read regularly with their children. It makes a huge difference and it is very pleasing to see the progress the children have made.
