## Art Appreciation

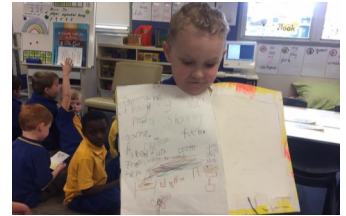


