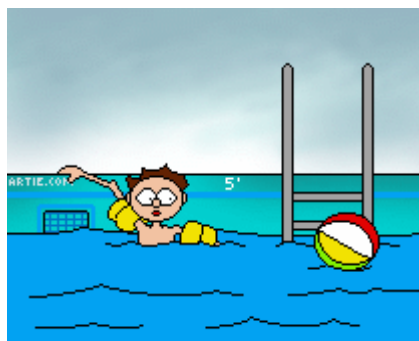

## **SWIM SCHOOL**

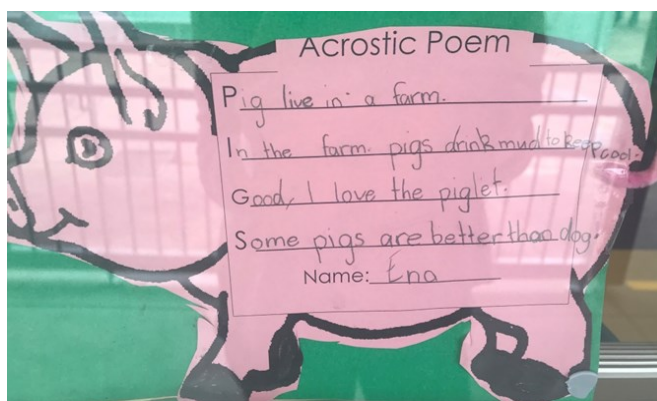
