## HALL CLOSURE

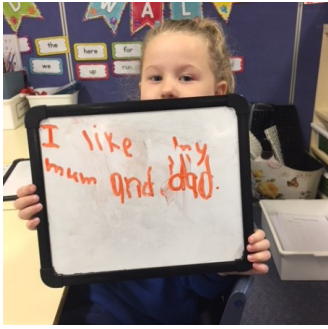

4/5L: Mrs Leten 5/6S: Mrs Sotiropoulos



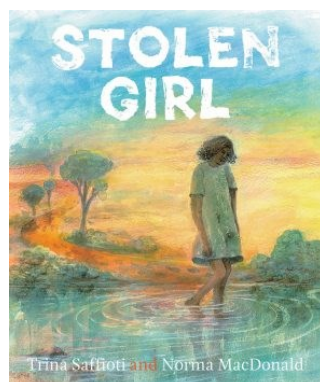
