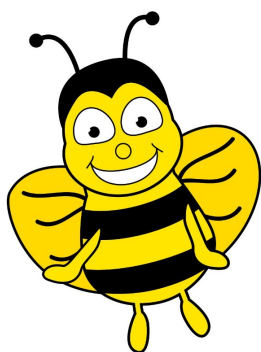
Head Lice
